
Preserve Avoid Retreat Re-align Accommodate Protect

Re-align:

The goal of the Re-align strategy is to change land use where public or private assets are exposed to significant risk. It is considered when other PARRAP categories are not sufficient to mitigate the risk or cannot be reasonably implemented due to constructability, permitting constraints, negative environmental impacts or where the cost to mitigate the risk is greater than the assets under threat.






Roads threatened by erosion

Road was moved 800m inland and realigned to maintain the integrity of the transportation corridor.







