

Field Services Assistant

Maitland Conservation is currently accepting applications for a Field Services Assistant. This is a summer student position. Possible funding source requires candidates to be between 15 – 30 years of age and be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident, or have refugee status in Canada, and be legally entitled to work in Canada for this position.

Anticipated Starting Date: May 1st, 2024

Duration: 18 weeks; 37.5 hours per week.

Location: Maitland Valley Conservation Authority Administration Centre in Wroxeter, Ontario

Job Description

Reporting to the Conservation Areas Coordinator, the candidate will be required to assist with field services activities at Maitland Conservation. Tasks will include general property maintenance including grass cutting, garbage collection, painting, tree pruning, building maintenance and inspections. Main project tasks will include planting and maintenance of trees and shrubs; trail maintenance activities including trail surface repairs, sign updates and boardwalk replacement. Other duties include vehicle and equipment maintenance and other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- Secondary school graduation or related experience.
- Willingness to work outdoors, occasionally under adverse weather conditions.
- Experience operating tractors, zero turn mowers, vehicles, and trailers.
- Experience performing carpentry as well as proper use of power tools and related equipment.
- Ability to work as part of a team and/or with minimum supervision.
- Good analytical, organizational and communications skills.
- Experience using word and excel programs.
- Valid Class G or G2 Ontario driver's license required.
- Ability to lift heavy objects.
- Chainsaw certification would be an asset.
- Police issued Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check required (applicants aged 18 and over)
- Work boots (green patch certified) are required.

Wage Rate: \$16.55 - \$20.55 per hour (37.5 hours per week)

Benefits: Eligibility to enroll in the OMERS pension plan.
