Pets are welcome at Falls Reserve Conservation Area. However, pet owners that do not comply with the Conservation Area Regulations may face fines and possible eviction.

Running through the park off leash.

Second charge:

Frightening/provoking wildlife and campers.

Fine: \$75.00



Charged With:

Disturbing the peace with uncontrolled barking (Dog Holiday was left alone at the campsite.)

Fine: \$75.00

Dog Paddle Peggy AKA: "The Swimmer"

Dirty Duke AKA: "The Dirty Dog"



Charged With:

Swimming in the pond.

Dogs are PROHIBITED from swimming in the pond.

Fine: \$75.00



Charged With:

Leaving dirty droppings in a public place. (His owner did not clean up after him.)

Fine: \$75.00

Snoopy Sneakers AKA: "The Sneak"

Chewy Charlie AKA: "The Destroyer"



Charged With:

Entering a public structure. (Pets are prohibited from all public structures).

Fine: Possible Eviction



Charged With:

Destroying park property or vegetation.

Second charge:

Destroying property of other campers and visitors.

Fine: \$75.00

If you encounter any of these

contact Park Patrol or the Park Gatehouse. The above fines or eviction may be issued.

Prevent your pet from becoming an outlaw.
