

## Pets in the Conservation Area Rules and Regulations

## **General Pet Information**

- 1. Dogs and cats are welcome at Falls Reserve.
- As a pet owner, it is your responsibility to prevent or stop nuisance pet behaviour from disturbing other visitors and to comply with all Conservation Area rules.
- Barking dogs can be an annoyance that disturbs other Conservation Area guests.
   Dogs found disturbing others with nuisance barking, will be evicted from the Conservation Area.
- 4. Be considerate of other visitors. Some people are afraid of, or allergic to dogs. Even the most well-behaved dog or cat can frighten or injure another visitor. Don't let your dog or cat approach anyone without their permission.
- 5. Dogs and cats are the only domestic animals allowed in the conservation area.

## **Pet Rules**

- 1. All pets are to be secured by a leash that is 2 metres (6 feet) or less at all times.
- 2. Pets will be considered "at large" if it is off leash or is on a leash that is more than 2 meters (6 feet) in length.
- 3. Make sure your pet stays on marked trails. This protects sensitive habitats and wildlife.
- 4. No person shall allow their pet to chase or harass wild animal or birds.
- 5. No person shall allow their pet to injure, or attempt to injure, a person or other pet.

- 6. No person shall allow their dog to bark excessively.
- 7. No person shall allow their dog or cat to disturb others (excessive barking or whining, wandering "at large" around the campground, etc.).
- 8. Only 2 pets are allowed per campsite.
- Pets shall not be left unattended at any time.
  This includes at the campsite, in a vehicle/trailer/tent or any other area in the Conservation Area.
- 10. Pets are not allowed in park buildings including washroom or shower facilities.
- 11. Pets are not allowed to swim or wade in the fishing pond.
- 12. Clean up after your pet and dispose of pet waste appropriately. Do not toss pet waste baggies in treed areas or leave pet waste bags along the trails, in firepits or other areas other then trash receptacles.
- 13. Pet owners shall provide adequate and appropriate care, food, water, shelter, exercise, attention and veterinary care as may be required to meet the pet's needs.
- 14. Any aggressive pet behaviour will result in immediate removal from the Conservation Area.

As a pet owner if you feel you cannot meet these pet rules, we ask that you leave your pet at home or at a boarding facility. It can be an inconvenience if you are required to remove your pet from the Conservation Area.
