




Maple Campground




Cedar Campground Radio and Audio Free Zone

After calling 911, it is **very important** that you contact the Gatehouse at 519-524-6429. Staff are required to follow up on any situation where police, emergency medical services or hospital services have been required in the park. Keep us informed!

Severe Storm Emergencies
 If a severe weather warning is issued, be prepared to bring together everyone in your party and seek shelter in a safe, secure area. Washroom buildings would be considered a safer place to seek shelter. **DO NOT** seek shelter from a tornado in your tent, mobile trailer or vehicle. If you're not able to get to a washroom building, seek shelter in a low lying area away from hazards such as overhead power lines and trees. After the storm, staff will assess any personal injuries, hazards and damages and take necessary actions. Contact staff or tune into local radio stations for weather forecasts or potential storm threats.

First Aid and Emergencies
 First aid kits for the treatment of minor cuts and scrapes are located at the park offices and in each park vehicle. Trained staff can provide basic first aid on request. For serious accidents, staff will provide assistance and put you in touch with professional care.
