Spring 2026 Tree and Shrub Order Form

Conditions of Ordering – Please Read:

1. An administration fee of \$20.00 is applied to each order.
2. Customers must order a minimum of 5 large stock or 50 seedlings.
3. Seedlings must be purchased in bundles of 10, with a minimum of 50 seedlings.
4. Trees and shrubs are **restoration grade stock** making them suitable for stewardship projects including windbreaks, watercourse or drain buffers, and retiring marginal land.
5. Customers are responsible for their **pickup at the Maitland Conservation Administration Centre in May 2026**. Maitland Conservation will reach out to schedule pickup dates and times in April 2026.
6. **Prices are subject to change** by spring depending on supplier cost and availability. Staff will notify customers of price changes and customers will receive invoices at the time of pickup
7. Deposits will be required for orders over \$5,000. Staff will connect with you in the new year to arrange deposit.
8. Maitland Conservation takes all precautions to ensure plants are distributed in the best possible condition. Due to environmental conditions beyond the control of Maitland Conservation, we assume no responsibility for the survival rate of trees and shrubs.

Other Site Considerations

Salt spray from roads can harm plants. Sensitive trees and shrubs that should be avoided near roadways, include:

- Sugar maple
- Red maple
- Black walnut
- Hackberry
- White pine
- Highbush cranberry

Black walnuts release a chemical that can inhibit other plant growth. Tolerant trees and shrubs that can be planted in close proximity include:

- White Cedar
- Sugar maple
- Red maple
- Oaks
- Bitternut hickory
- Kentucky Coffee Tree
- Hemlock
- Sycamore
- Tulip tree
- Sandbar willow
- Red-osier dogwood
- American Hazelnut
- Elderberry
- Red Cedar
- Hackberry
- Spicebush
- Ninebark
- Serviceberry
